Jaap Leegwater is a widely known and highly sought after dance teacher from The Netherlands, specializing in Bulgarian dance. Since 1969 he has made many trips to Bulgaria, researching village dances, participating in rehearsals with several dance ensembles, and studying with some of Bulgaria's best folklorists and choreographers. He has conducted workshops and dance seminars in many countries including The Netherlands, Germany, Switzerland, Sweden, Israël, England, United States, Canada, Japan, Taiwan, and Hong Kong and at many major dance camps including Maine Woods, Stockton, the EEFC Balkan Music and Dance Camp, Montreal International Folk Dance Camp, Ontario Folk Dance Camp and Bulgarian Festivals in Vancouver.

Mea Nordenfelt

Mea is a dance educator from Sweden. Her field of expertise extends from pre-school, primary school, elderly care to rehabilitation. Mea has been working as dancer and teacher for more than 30 years. As dancer she worked professionally with renowned International Folkloristic Dance Theater in The Netherlands. A dance therapist she has been working with the deaf-blind since 2006. In addition Mea has her own weekly IFD class at the International Folk Dance Club in Stockholm, Sweden.
